

Carson Country USBC Alumni & Youth Inaugural Tournament April 27, 2024, 1:00 pm checkin HomeGrown Bowl 4600 Snyder Ave. Carson City, Nevada

- 1. This tournament is open to CCUSBC youth and adults who bowled in the CCUSBC association area as youth (alumni). Initial plan is doubles with one alumnus and one youth. Individuals may enter by April 25, 2024, and Tournament Management will create teams, unless teams are specified at entry. If the number of entrants allow, teams may be increased to trios, especially this inaugural year. The goal is to have one alumnus per team to provide all the youth an opportunity to bowl with an alumni member.
- 2. This is a no-tap (9 pins on first ball counts as a strike) tournament. Four consecutive games shall be bowled and total pins, with handicap, shall decide the winner.
- 3. Entry fee will be \$25.00 for alumni and youth with lineage \$10.00, youth scholarship fund, \$15.00. The entry fees may be paid by cash, check or Zeffy. Make checks payable to CCUSBC Youth. Entrant is responsible for all returned checks; a \$40.00 collection fee will be charged. If a check is returned, the entrant will be required to pay the entry fee and bank fees via cash prior to squad time or entry will be voided.
- 4. This tournament will be handicapped at 100% of 225. All sport averages will be converted to standard averages for the tournament. Entering averages will be determined as follows:
 - a. USBC members (youth and alumni) will use their highest USBC sanctioned league average.
 - Averages will be determined in the following order:
 - i. Highest current winter average
 - ii. Highest summer league average of at least 21 games
 - iii. Most recent book average if not current bowler
 - b. Non-USBC member adults:
 - i. Females will enter at 150.
 - ii. Males will enter at 170.
- 5. Tournament will start at 1:30 pm. Entrants are required to check at least 30 minutes prior for lane assignments.
- 6. A baked goods raffle will be held and funds added to the scholarship prize for this tournament.
- 7. All prize funds, alumni and youth, will be returned 100% to youth participants as scholarships in SMART accounts. All youth bowlers will receive a scholarship, the amount to be determined based on number of entries. Top 3 alumni and youth will have bragging rights and will receive award tags for their plaques.
- 8. In the event of a tie for scholarships, money for the places tied will be divided accordingly.
- 9. Only bowlers and officials will be allowed in the playing area. <u>No alcohol</u> is to be consumed during this tournament. No food or beverages will be allowed in the playing area. Only tournament officials will be allowed to correct scores.
- 10. Bowlers using loud or abusive language or conduct unbecoming of a bowler shall have one warning. If misconduct continues, bowler will be removed from the lanes. The bowler will forfeit any awards and scholarship money to that event.
- 11. Reasonable attire is required, and determination is at the discretion of the Tournament Management.
- 12. The tournament officials are empowered to remove a player for an infraction of USBC and/or CCUSBC rules and regulations that apply to this tournament.
- 13. The oil pattern will be the house shot that has been used for a minimum of 2 weeks prior to the start of the tournament.
