1. This is a no-tap (9 pins on your first ball counts as a strike) tournament and is open to adult and youth bowlers.
2. Entry fee will be \$29.00 for adults and \$19.00 for youths. The entry fees may be paid by cash, credit card, check or money order. Make checks payable to CCUSBC. Entrant is responsible for all returned checks; a \$40.00 collection fee will be charged. If a check is returned, the entrant will be required to pay the entry fee and bank fees via cash prior to squad time or entry will be voided. Walk-in entries must be paid with cash or credit card.
3. This tournament will be handicapped at 100% of 225. Entering averages will be determined as follows:
 - a. USBC members (youth and adult) will use their highest USBC sanctioned league average. Averages will be determined in the following order:
 - 1) Highest winter 2019-20 book average
 - 2) Highest summer 2020 league average of at least 21 games
 - 3) Highest 2018-19 book average
 - 4) Highest current league average of at least 21 games
 - b. Non-USBC member adults:
 - 1) Females will enter at 150
 - 2) Males will enter at 170
 - c. Non-USBC member youths:
 - 1) Age 16 and over will enter at 141
 - 2) Age 13-15 will enter at 119
 - 3) Age 10-12 will enter at 94
 - 4) Age 7-9 will enter at 55
 - 5) Age 6 and under will enter at 25 (no bumper bowlers)
4. Entrants are required to check in no less than 30 minutes prior to squad time for lane assignments.
5. All adult prize money will be returned 100% on a ratio of 1 in 4 bowlers, or major portion thereof. Prize checks will be distributed within 30 days after the tournament closes.
6. In the event of a tie for cash prizes, money for the places tied will be divided accordingly.
7. Three consecutive games shall be bowled and total pins, with handicap, shall decide the winner.
8. Only bowlers and officials will be allowed in the playing area. No food or beverages will be allowed in the playing area. Only tournament officials will be allowed to program, correct and record scores.
9. Bowlers using loud or abusive language or conduct unbecoming of a bowler shall have one warning. If misconduct continues, bowler will be removed from the lanes. The bowler will forfeit any awards and prize money to that event.
10. Reasonable attire is required, and determination is at the discretion of the Tournament Management.
11. The tournament officials are empowered to remove a player for an infraction of USBC and/or CCUSBC rules and regulations that apply to this tournament.
12. The oil pattern will be the house shot that has been used for a minimum of 2 weeks prior to the start of the tournament.
13. Masks will be worn in accordance with the houses requirements.
14. This tournament will be subject to a second squad if we receive more than 70 Bowlers. We will have no more than 5 bowlers per pair.
