1. **ELIGIBILITY:** The tournament is open to boys and girls who hold a current USBC Youth Division certification card. Non-members are not eligible. This is a USBC Youth Certified Event.
2. **ENTRY:** You are encouraged to submit your entry **on or before** January 22, 2022. Entries will be accepted until 8:30 am on January 23, 2022. If you cannot get your entry form to the tournament director by 9 pm on January 22, 2022, and you wish to bowl, please call or text the tournament director and provide your information by the January 22 deadline.
3. **ENTERING AVERAGE:** Averages to be used for the purpose of determining a bowler’s Division, for this tournament, will be as follows:
 1. Highest 9 games or more average as of January 22, 2022.
 2. If A does not apply, highest 2020-21 book average of 21 games or more.
 3. If no average is available from A or B above, the bowler will be placed in the A Division.

Average verification is required. If the average is from the 2020-21 average books, verification will be made through *bowl.com*. If the average is a January 22, 2022, average from a current league, a copy of the standing sheet is required and must be provided by the bowler.

4. **FEES:** The entry fee must accompany this entry (checks payable to “CCUSBC YOUTH”), and will be:

5. **FORMAT:** The tournament will consist of three divisions of SCRATCH SINGLES bowling the following number of games:

	Qualifying	Semi-Finals
Divisions A & B	6	3
Division C	3	3

A minimum of 8 bowlers are the optimum for each Division, for that Division to hold competition. If the optimum number of bowlers is not met, the tournament Director will have the option of combining entries to hold a Division or allowing a Division to have fewer than 8 entries. If bowlers do not agree to the decision, they may request their entry fee returned.

6. **SEMI-FINALS and FINALS:** One bowler in two (1 in 2) in each division will qualify for the semi-finals with a minimum of eight per division. Semi-finalists will bowl 3 games of head to head competition. The pin totals from the qualifying round **will not** carry forward. The first match play game will be 1st place vs. last place, 2nd place vs second to last place, etc. The second match play game will be a random draw and the third match play game will be a position round based on scores from the 1st two match play game finals. The winner of each semi-final match will receive 20 bonus pins. In case of a tie during the semi-final match, each bowler will receive 10 bonus pins. The top eight finishers from the semi-final round will advance to the stepladder finals. The eighth, seventh and sixth place finishers will bowl one game. The winner of that game will bowl the fifth and fourth place finishers. The winner of that game will bowl the third place finisher. The winner of that game will bowl the second place finisher and the winner of that game will bowl the first place finisher for the winner of the division. In case of a tie during the stepladder finals, the bowlers will have a 9th and 10th frame roll off until a winner can be determined. The winners of Division A and Division B shall bowl one game to determine the overall Northern Nevada Master's Champion.
7. **AWARDS:** All award fees will be returned 100% in scholarships. A minimum scholarship of \$150.00 shall be awarded to the top finisher in each Division. The High Qualifier for each Division, from the qualifying round, will be awarded a \$50.00 scholarship. A \$50.00 scholarship will be awarded to the overall winner of the Northern Nevada Master's Title. The dollar amount and number of scholarships awarded may increase depending on the number of entries in each Division. The final amount of the scholarships to be awarded will be based on the number of entrants and the amount to be contributed to the tournament from Carson Country USBC. Scholarship funds will be forwarded to the SMART Program, account # 9833, at the National USBC office.
8. **LANE ASSIGNMENTS:** The tournament director shall determine the lane assignments for the first game of the qualifying round. Bowlers shall move one pair of lanes to the right after each game.
9. **DRESS CODE:** Appropriate tournament dress code is required. All entrants may wear a shirt imprinted with their name, name of bowling team, league, club or center logo OR a collared shirt with sleeves. Boys shall wear pants or walking shorts. Girls shall wear pants, skirts, walking shorts, or skorts. All skirts, shorts, or skorts must be no more than 2 inches above the knee. Apparel made of elastic or spandex type material will not be permitted. Clothes must be clean and in good repair. Parachute pants, warm-up suits or fleece garments are not allowed. Pants may not be sagged or dragging on the floor. No headgear of any kind may be worn. No bare midriffs. Bowlers will not be allowed to check-in unless properly dressed. In case of a question regarding the bowler's attire, a committee of at least three Carson Country USBC Youth shall determine if the bowler meets the dress code requirements.
10. **CHECK-IN:** Pre-registered bowlers must check-in at Carson Lanes in Carson City, NV, by 9:00 am on January 23, 2022. Walk-in bowlers must register no later than 8:30 am.
11. **PROTESTS – RULE 329:** Protests involving eligibility or playing rules must be made to tournament manager in writing within the time limits in Rule 329. The decision of tournament management will be final unless a written appeal is filed with USBC Headquarters within the time limits of Rule 329.
12. All rules and regulations not specifically covered in these rules follow in accordance with USBC Rules.
